

## FARINA FRAGRANCE MUSEUM

This original Farina scent is elegant and subtle. This delicate fragrance starts with light citrus notes of bergamot, orange, grapefruit and lemon; then an equally delicate second layer includes tender jasmine and violet; finished with soothing base notes of warm sandalwood and the most delicate musk: olibanum.





This fragrance oil is the original Eau de Cologne, made in 1709 in the factory now known as the Farina Fragrance Museum in Cologne, Germany. Its inventor, Giovanni Maria Farina, wrote this in 1708: "I have discovered a scent that reminds me of a spring morning in Italy, of mountain narcissus, orange blossom just after the rain. It gives me great refreshment, strengthens my senses and imagination."



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
